Re: Annual Marillac Security/Stipulation Compliance Report

Please find attached the annual Marillac Security/Stipulation Compliance report, pursuant to Special Use Permit No. 1004-15 under Ordinance No. Z-3075.

The 2009 review showed Marillac had successfully complied with all stipulations with the exception of one incident involving an elopement. In that instance a 15 year old female ran from the facility, and was followed by a staff member. The staff member never lost sight of the juvenile, who ran to the nearby CVS Pharmacy. The juvenile was apprehended by the staff member and returned to Marillac without incident. A Marillac supervisor did contact the Police Department, however, did not notify the Blue Valley School District, per Stipulation F.

Mr. Kevin Choe, Operations Administrator for Marillac, indicated their interpretation of the Elopement Protocol led them not to make this notification. In short, because their staff member never lost sight of the client, they did not believe the call to BVSD was required.

I reviewed the Elopement Protocol with Mr. Choe, and summarized by advising that he direct his staff to contact both the Police Department and the BVSD in the event of any and all elopements.

Officer Mike Betten conducted a walk-through, and found physical security and security procedures at Marillac were acceptable.

Mr. Kevin Choe, Operations Administrator for Marillac, assisted us in our review of the facility, as well as their compliance with the Special Use Permit stipulations.
