

RESOLUTION NO. 3808

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENTS FOR A FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT ALONG INDIAN CREEK BETWEEN ROE AVENUE AND MISSION ROAD, IN THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS (**I.D. NO. 07-193**).

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas did, on the 21st day of May, 2007, adopt Resolution No. 3591 setting forth the advisability of the following improvement:

Construction of a flood control project along Indian Creek between Roe Avenue and Mission Road, to reduce flooding and benefit various properties adjacent to Indian Creek, including the following locations: part of Section 9, Township 13 South, Range 25 East, including but not limited to, land in FOX HILL COMMERCIAL CENTER, a subdivision, all of which lies within the City of Overland Park, Johnson County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body did, on the 21st day of May, 2007, adopt Resolution No. 3592 authorizing the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the above-stated improvement district has been determined; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, to cause the assessments on each lot, piece, or parcel of land deemed to be benefited by the aforesaid improvement district to be determined and a public hearing to be held with regard to those assessments according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

That the City Clerk publish a notice of public hearing to consider the proposed assessments on the aforesaid improvement district setting forth the date, time and place of such meeting, the general nature of the improvement, and its costs, the extent of the improvement district proposed to be assessed, and that written or oral objections will be considered at such hearing. The Clerk is further directed to mail to the owners of the property made liable to pay the assessment, at their last known post office address, a notice of the hearing and a statement of the costs proposed to be assessed against the land so owned and assessed.
