**RE:** Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to KDOT Agreement No. 49-07  
Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) for the purchase of Alternate  
Fuel Vehicles (KDOT Project No. 46 N-0453-01).

**ISSUE:** KDOT requires Governing Body approval of all City-State Agreements.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends approval of Supplemental Agreement No.  
1.

**BACKGROUND:** The City applied for Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) funding for the purchase of alternate fuel vehicles covering the years 2006 - 2008. The original KDOT Agreements stated the City would receive a total amount of \$128,000 over the three year period. These Supplemental Agreements are to clarify the terms of the original grant which stated the City would be reimbursed \$8,000.00 per vehicle purchased. Because the City purchased 14 of the 16 vehicles originally requested we are only entitled to \$112,000 in total for the 14 vehicles.

**BUDGET IMPACT:** There is no budget impact to operating budgets for this year. The City will receive \$24,000 of the \$40,000 anticipated for the 2008 period.
