When: 05-05-10 through 11-17-10

Where: The parking lot south of Farmers' Market parking & adjacent to The Other Place.

Parking: *Two full rows on the south side of the parking lot, approximately 48 of the 168 total available spaces, or 28%, will be cordoned off by means of orange construction cones.
*A handicapped space with van accessibility will be available in the southwest corner of the proposed parking area.
*A total of 4 handicapped spaces and 116 regular spaces will be available to the general public.

Attendance: 50-200 motorcyclists weekly

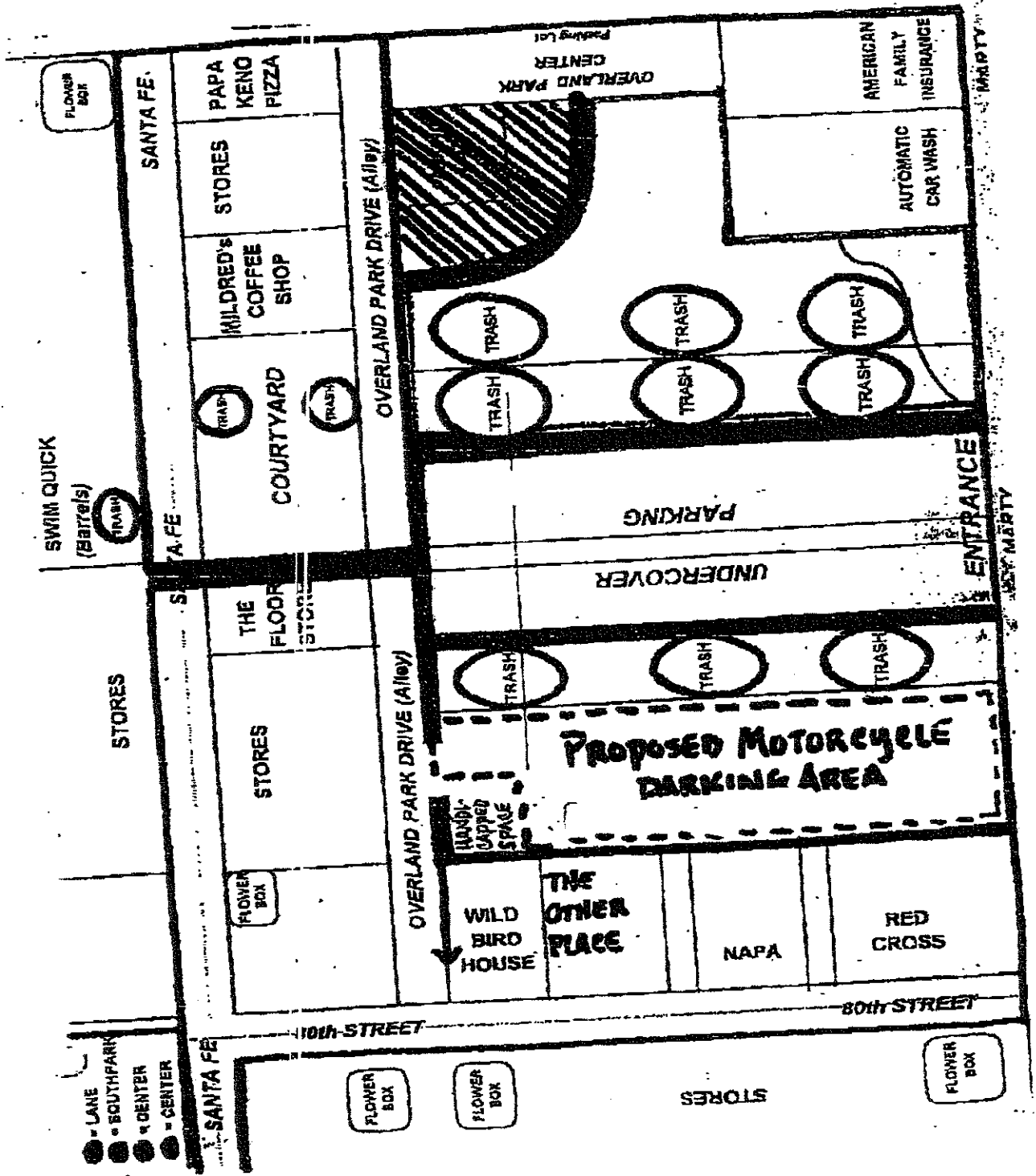
Alcohol: Will not be served or consumed outside the physical building.

Security: The Other Place will provide easily identifiable security personnel.

Insurance: General liability coverage with Brummbel Madsen in the amount of \$1,000,000.00

Clean-Up: The Other Place will provide weekly clean-up personnel.
