A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING POLICY ON SNOW PLOWING AND ICE CONTROL AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. ~~2897~~3495.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee of the City Council at its meeting on the ~~21st~~28th day of ~~November, 2005~~April, 2010, recommended to the City Council certain operating policies and procedures relating to snow plowing and ice control; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, did on the ~~5th~~3rd day of ~~December, 2005~~May, 2010, find such policies and procedures to be acceptable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

That the following policies and procedures are adopted:

I. SNOW ~~PLOWING~~ AND ICE CONTROL POLICY: ~~All streets shall be plowed or treated with chemicals according to the following priority ratings:~~

A. Snow and ice control services shall be prioritized as follows:

Priority 1: Main thoroughfares and bridges on same routes.

Priority 2: Collector and commercial/industrial streets.

Priority 3: Residential streets and cul-de-sacs.

~~Priority 1 and 2 streets will be plowed continuously while snow is falling and/or treated with the appropriate chemicals and abrasives (calcium chloride, sodium chloride, sand, or a combination thereof) for ice control.~~

~~Priority 3 streets will be plowed or treated with chemicals and abrasives as soon as Priority 2 streets are completed.~~

~~If ice or light snow (less than two inches) occurs, only chemicals and/or abrasives will be applied to Priority 3 streets.~~

B. Emergency Service Requests:

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES: ~~Persons requesting snow and ice control resources due to a reported who have medical emergency, fire or other public safety urgency will be referred to call 911. Snow and ice control resources will be emergencies requiring snow removal equipment to be diverted from established priorities will be referred to provide 911 for verification of the emergency service support upon request. On notification by any Police, Fire or 911 personnel,~~

II. SNOW AND ICE CONTROL PROCEDURES

A. Streets and bridges shall be plowed that a medical emergency exists, equipment will be diverted to provide access for the emergency vehicles to and/or treated with chemical de-icing materials in accordance with the City's Snow and Ice Control Manual as annually adopted or updated by the Public Works Department. from the location of the emergency.

B. Snow and ice control chemicals and/or abrasives shall be compliant with current state and federal environmental regulations.
