RE: Bid Tabulation
School Beacon Upgrade

ISSUE: City policy requires Governing Body acceptance of competitive bids for equipment costing more than \$10,000.00

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends accepting the lowest, responsive bid from Gades Sales Co. for the amount of \$49,987.00.

BACKGROUND: The bid is for furnishing equipment to replace the city's existing one-way pager based flashing school beacon clocks to wireless Ethernet. The city received 3 bids, two of which were responsive. The 3rd bid from Mid-American Signal was lower (\$42,715) but the bid included an alternate product that is not compatible with existing clocks that the City currently uses.

BUDGET IMPACT: There is sufficient funding available in the project budget MT-1315.
