ACTION ITEM:

Addendums to User Agreements between the City of Overland Park and the following agencies for Intergraph usage:

- Johnson County Park and Recreation District
- City of Lenexa
- City of Merriam
- City of Olathe
- City of Prairie Village
- City of Shawnee

POLICY ISSUE:

Whether to approve the Addendums to the Intergraph User Agreements with the above listed agencies.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approval of the Addendums to the Intergraph User Agreements with the above listed agencies.

BACKGROUND:

Due to connectivity and license issues specific to each agency, changes were made to reflect such in **Article 2, OBLIGATIONS OF USER AGENCY** for Johnson County Park & Recreation, The City of Lenexa and the City of Merriam. Johnson County Park & Recreation and the City of Merriam utilize the connectivity provided by other agencies, and utilize licenses provided by the City of Overland Park; therefore, are not required to meet all the requirements set forth in Article 2 of the Intergraph User Agreement. The City of Lenexa is unique in its use of Intergraph and currently has a separate Connectivity Agreement with the City of Overland Park.

In addition, due to changes in how the City of Overland Park will be billing for future Intergraph upgrades, changes were made in the language to **Article 6, CONSIDERATION** for all above agencies. The City of Overland Park will no longer require estimated payment for upgrades on an annual basis. The City of Overland Park currently plans an upgrade to the Intergraph system every three (3) years, or as deemed necessary. The City of Overland Park will negotiate the upgrades necessary with vendor and will appropriately distribute this cost to participating agencies once this contract has been negotiated.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The payments received will assist in offsetting costs associated with Overland Park's operation of the system.
