


## Infrastructure Investment Assurance

This document serves as certification that the infrastructure investments partially or fully funded with Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funds have received the full review and vetting required by law and that that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of EECBG funds.


The infrastructure investments in the City's EECBG program are as follows:
